Place small dinosaur toys (or any toys) in the sand.</p>
<p>Shape Hunt & Sort Find squares, circles, triangles, rectangles... Count & sort by other attributes big to small, color, texture...</p>	<p>Pets Write and/or draw a story about your pets. Tell the story to your pets!</p>	<p>Personal Information Practice your child's full name, age, birthday, parent's full name, parent's phone number, and full address.</p>	<p>Stuffed Animal Audience Read a book, tell a story, or play school with your stuffed animals and toys.</p>	<p>Kitchen Help Spread butter, peel and cut bananas, squeeze juice, wash dishes, pour water, set the table.</p>	<p>Guess the Smell Gather oranges, cinnamon, pepper, soap or other fragrant materials. See if kids can guess what it is without looking.</p>
